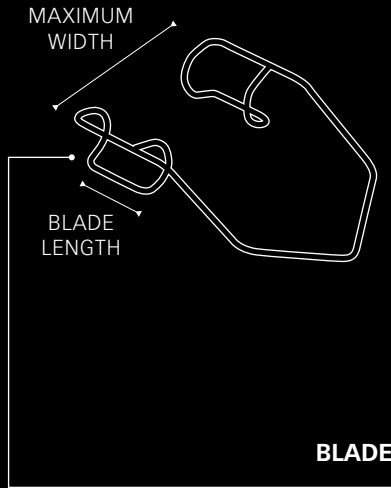
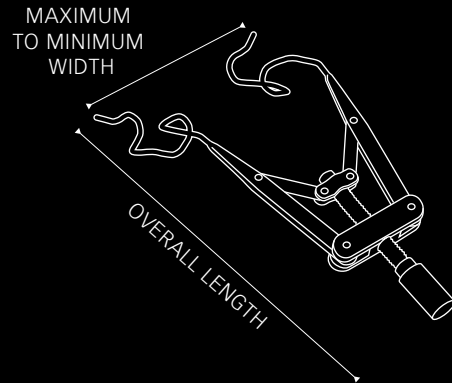


Specula anatomy

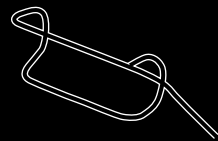
NON-ADJUSTABLE



ADJUSTABLE



Open: allows good access for instruments
e.g. Phaco handpiece that might otherwise rest on the top bar of a closed blade making surgery difficult



Closed: good hold on eyelids for procedures where the top bar does not cause a problem
e.g. trabeculectomy or temporal incision phaco



Wire: more comfortable for the patient under local anaesthetic, particularly when used with a sliding wire speculum or a non-adjustable speculum



Solid: holds eyelids securely
